

Donkey (1) 203 Welford Road LE2 6BH Live music venue which sometimes requires an admission charge. Three real ales.

77 Queen's Road LE2 1TT

Sophisticated two floor café-style bar favoured by urban professionals. Up to three ales.

Queen's Road Tap (9) 109 Queen's Road LE2 1TT Opened December 2017. Tollgate's quiet micropub has hand pumps for 4 beers plus real ciders.

Dos Hermanos 🙃 54 Queen's Road LE2 1TU Spanish-style bar adjacent to Barceloneta restaurant. Three real ales.

22 Allandale Road LE2 2DA

Aberdale W Shackerdale Road LE2 6HT Large, child-friendly Everards community pub serving an extensive local area. Two real ales.

Everard's village pub in what is now a suburb. Beer garden and extensive food menu.

**Aylestone** Leicestershire County Cricket Ground To the South West of the city Avlestone has four Real Ale outlets, all within easy walking distance of bus routes 84, 84A, 85, 87 and in the case of the main village the Outer Circle route 40

Black Horse W 65 Narrow Lane LE2 8NA Traditional Victorian pub with beer garden, 8 real ales & home-cooked food, Skittles & comedy nights. Union Inn W 27 Middleton Street LE2 8LU Marston's traditional two-roomed wet-trade only pub. Large rear split-level patio. 4 real ales. Ale Stone W 660 Aylestone Road LE2 8PR Sister micropub to The Blue Boar. 5 real ales plus 4 ciders & perries. Bar snacks & coffee available. Cricketers (7) 1 Grace Road LE2 8AD

Overlooks Leicestershire County Cricket ground. Child-friendly patio area. Everards beers plus guests.

## Other Areas (not on maps)

Tom Hoskins is approximately 25 - 30 minutes walk along the A6 St Margarets Way (or catch buses 126,127, 154, Kinch 2) to the north of the City Centre. Heathley Park is a 40 minute walk to the north west of the city served by all Groby Road buses that stop at or near Gilroes Cemetery/Glenfield Hospital and Outer Circle route 40/41. To the East of the city Evington has two pubs; The Dove and The Cedars (buses 22, 22A, 22B and 22C to the city centre serve both pubs and several other routes are within ten minutes walk).

Heathley Park W Groby Road/Heathley Park Drive LE3 9QE Large room split into bar and dining areas. Food is available from breakfast onwards. 4 real ales. Cedars 🕕 Main Street, Evington LE5 6DN Attractive, food and family-orientated former private house and gardens. Two real ales. 48 Downing Drive, Evington LE5 6LH Refurbished early 2016. Extensive dining and garden areas, 4 Everards beers always available
